

The hand bolts (red arrows) should be untightened.

Be careful of the white washers...there are 4 in total (2 on each bolt...one on the outside of the glass and the other on the inside).

From that point gently pull the heater away from the glass from the top.

The bottom may need a little wiggle if its in a recess in the floor.



Tilt the heater down until you can lie it down flat somewhere on the sauna floor.



Feel around for the opening at the bottom of the heater and pull out its cord from the bottom of it.

You'll see now that the heaters cord is connected to the one in the floor.



Unplug the heater cord from the floor cord and remove the heater.



Now working backwards, plug your new heater into the floor cord and tuck the connection back into the opening on the bottom of the heater.



Best way to proceed from here is to place your bolts back into the holes with one washer on the outside and one on the inside.



Tilt the new heater back up...making sure thats its in the floor recess.

Depending on your sauna model, you can merely hold the heater up and reach around with your other hand to start tightening the bolts to secure it to the glass.



You're all done from there!
